As Mayor of Quesnel and a member of the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee, I am pleased to provide a letter of support to the Quesnel Rodeo Club for their grant application(s) to Northern Development Initiative Trust for a new washroom facility near the grandstand in Alex Fraser Park.

This site is home to many large-scale events hosted by multiple non-profit organizations from Quesnel & area. The former portable washroom facility has been condemned by Northern Health and representatives of the Quesnel Rodeo Club and the Alex Fraser Park Society have attended the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee to advocate for a new washroom facility in close proximity to the grandstand at the park. The only other washroom facility on the site is a significant walk, outside the entry gate and does not have the capacity to accommodate the volume of attendees at the large events.

The Quesnel Rodeo Club and Alex Fraser Park Society have been very proactive in researching availability and optimal cost for a replacement portable facility. As the 2026 rodeo and agricultural season approaches, I urge you to consider grant funding for the Quesnel Rodeo Club's application for a new washroom facility at Alex Fraser Park.
