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## Short Summary:

NDIT Application – 108 Mile Ranch Community Association – Outdoor Washroom Facility

## Memorandum:

For the Cariboo Regional District Board's consideration, please find attached an application to the Northern Development Initiative Trust (NDIT) from the 108 Mile Ranch Community Association. The request is for \$30,000 in funding under the Community Places stream to install an outdoor washroom facility to serve the outdoor activity area at the 108 Mile Ranch Community Hall property. The addition will enhance site functionality, user comfort, improve accessibility and support compliance with applicable health and safety requirements.

Funding support for this project, which has a total value of \$53,128.68, is anticipated to come from Northern Development Initiative Trust (\$30,000), the 108 Mile Ranch Community Association (\$20,128.68) and the South Cariboo Pickleball Association (\$3,000).

Prior to forwarding the application to NDIT for the Regional Advisory Committee's consideration, all Regional Development Account applications require a resolution of support from the local government within the jurisdiction.
