Re: Virtual streaming and recording options for NCJAC meetings

Dear Chair Wagner and Members of the Cariboo Regional District Board,

At its Regular Meeting on March 17, 2026, the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee (NCJAC) passed a resolution to refer the issue of recording Committee meetings and posting them on the City of Quesnel website, back to the CRD Board for reconsideration.

The Committee understands that the Board has concerns about maintaining consistency and that presently other advisory committees do not have their meetings recorded and posted on-line. The Committee also recognizes that some Board members expressed concern that resolutions made by any advisory committee, including the NCJAC, are only recommendations until they are ratified by the appropriate governing body and that posting videos of these meetings on-line may result in heightened awareness of recommendations that haven't yet been approved by the Board.

NCJAC meetings in Quesnel are already different in many ways from other CRD and City advisory committees. They have a long and established history of attracting media attention and community engagement. Opting not to record and post these meetings on-line won't prevent the media from reporting on these meetings. Since community and media interest is already high, the Committee maintains that it makes sense to post videos of these meetings on-line to improve transparency.


Quesnel City Council currently records and posts video of Council meetings on-line. As a result, residents of the North Cariboo have become accustomed to this process which has led to requests for this practice to be extended to include NCJAC meetings. While recording and posting videos of meetings may not be a consistent practice throughout the Regional District, it is an expectation that many residents of the North Cariboo have.

Because the City administers the North Cariboo Recreation and Parks Service and because the City currently records and posts Council meetings on-line, this is something


that City staff can easily accommodate without any cost to the North Cariboo Recreation and Parks Service.

In light of this, the North Cariboo Joint Advisory Committee requests the Cariboo Regional District Board support video recording of NCJAC open meetings and posting these recordings to the City of Quesnel YouTube channel to enhance public transparency and community engagement.
