
Further to our communication earlier this month, this letter is in response to the questions regarding winter plug-ins and exterior stairs covers for the parking included in the Cariboo Memorial Hospital (CMH) Redevelopment Project.

Interior Health recognizes the need for electrical plug-ins for parking stalls, given the winter conditions in the Cariboo. Due to the limited time we had to get the parking changes completed at the site to have certain work done prior to winter, some scope has not been completed for the new parking areas, and some parking areas are still to be completed later in the project. This work has been scoped and the team will install power outlets later this year.

In relation to the external stairs, we are currently considering the best solution for this item, considering materials and maintenance optimization.

Thank you for bringing these concerns to our attention. We will be happy to provide updates on this project to the Regional Hospital District on a regular basis and to continue to address any questions as they arise.
