The Claymine Trails are an important community asset in Bouchie Lake and are well-used by the local elementary school for nature classes, seniors' walking groups and parents with young children either in strollers or just getting their own feet under them.

Trail counters employed at the site recorded an average daily use of over 13 persons with a high of more than 600 over the Halloween weekend, when the Commission decorates the low mobility trail as a haunted forest experience.

The original wheelchair accessible trail was constructed in 2014 and has proven to be a very popular asset. Ten years later, the site is due for some additional investment to maintain existing use as well as increase the opportunities to explore new areas of the forest. Adding another 1000 metres of trail will triple the amount of accessible terrain available for persons with mobility concerns.

The Bouchie Lake Hall and grounds is a popular rental facility for events such as weddings and family reunions. The Claymine Trails provide a nearby amenity for groups renting the hall, adding to its attractiveness and marketability.

The Regional District, working with numerous partners including non-profit groups, municipalities and the province, has completed more that 25 wheelchair accessible wilderness trail projects across the Cariboo. These outdoor recreation assets have been extremely popular from their initial construction and continue to validate this build concept.

Cultural awareness is fostered through the connection with nature that the Claymine Trails exemplify. The low mobility trail, by design and purpose, is inclusive and serves to remove barriers to outdoor recreation and healthy natural spaces for all persons.

A focus of the project is to enhance access to the natural environment in the community by creating more opportunity for all persons to immerse themselves in the outdoors.

The trails are intended to be a low maintenance asset and have proven to be exceptional value when compared to other more cost-intensive recreation assets, such as ice rink and swimming pools.
